Registration

Who may register?

Prospective students must have submitted their applications and been accepted to Holy Trinity before attempting to register for courses. All students currently enrolled in a degree program may register to take or audit courses. Anyone may audit Master of Ministry and Associate of Theological Study courses.

Step 1: Seek any special permission, approval, or academic advising.

Newly accepted students for both the Master of Ministry and Associate of Theological Studies programs must schedule an academic advising session before registering for courses. Students already matriculated are encouraged to seek academic advising when auditing courses or altering the standard course load. Schedule appointments through the Holy Trinity office at (410) 861-6876.

Step 2: Fill out the registration form.

Fill out the registration form indicating desired course by name and number, whether the course will be taken for a grade or as an audit, and the corresponding costs. Total all credits and costs at the bottom of the form.

Step 3: Send in the registration form and remit payment.

Registration is not complete until it is returned with payment to Holy Trinity. Registration forms and payment must be post-marked by the last day of registration to avoid late registration fees.

Tuition, Expenses, and Financial Aid

Holy Trinity is committed to providing a quality education at a very reasonable cost. Students are encouraged to seek sponsorship from their local parishes or from individuals if they are not able to meet the tuition and fees on their own. The following section describes typical costs and expenses incurred by students. **Tuition and fees may only be paid by check payable to Christ the King Church with the notation "Seminary."**
